The undersigned affiant, being duly sworn, deposes and says:

1. That, the affiant, Officer Owen Ochs is a regular member of the New Canaan Police Department and has been a member of said department for the past six years, and at all pertinent times mentioned herein the affiant was acting in his official capacity as member of said department. The following facts and circumstances are stated from personal knowledge, observation, and investigation, as well as from information received from fellow officers acting in their official capacity.

2. That, on 01/27/2024 (Saturday) at 2008HRS the affiant was dispatched to 613 New Norwalk RD, New Canaan, CT on the report of a dog that has been barking for the past two (2) days. Prior to arriving at that address, the affiant looked up the history at that address and noticed a previous animal call on 11/04/2023 (NCPD Case #23-12464) for a similar complaint made against the dog's owner, Jack Hawkins who at the time of that incident was away as a reservist in the U.S. military on weekend duty.

3. That, upon arrival the affiant observed a black and white colored, female Border Collie dog lying on the front grass. The house was dark and no vehicles were located in the driveway. The affiant then approached the dog and she was whimpering. The dog was cold to the touch. Per the thermometer in NCPD Car#9 it was 39 degrees Fahrenheit at the time of my arrival. The grass was wet and muddy due to the recent rain. The dog then began following me and grabbing onto on my leg in a manner as if looking for aid. In the front yard by the house the affiant observed a plastic tan-colored igloo style dog house. The affiant looked inside the dog house and the ground/floor was wet grass and leaves. The affiant observed no insulation or anything else for warmth, nor any food or water source in it or in the immediate area. The affiant went to the front door and attempted to make contact with any resident. There was no answer. The affiant then walked to the garage area of the driveway and the garage door

was completely shut. In NCPD Case #23-12464, Hawkins stated to NCPD that the dog could enter the residence through the garage for shelter. The dog then ran to a Home Depot five-gallon bucket that was filled with water and began drinking from it. Upon looking inside the bucket, it had leaves, dirt, and other sediment in it. It appeared to be filled by the recent rain and not by Hawkins or any other individual.

4. That, NCPD Dispatch contacted Hawkins who stated he was in New Haven and would not be at his residence tonight, but would attempt to find a care taker for the dog. It should be noted New Haven does have a U.S. military reserve center. The affiant then put the dog in the Prisoner Compartment of NCPD #9 for approximately 15 minutes so the dog could warm up. After, the affiant then had to lift the dog out of the Prisoner Compartment of NCPD #9 as it would not leave, despite the fact the dog followed all my other commands during this incident. The affiant then departed the scene.

5. That, Hawkins contacted NCPD at approximately 2100HRS and stated his neighbor at REDACTED REDACTED would take custody of the dog at 2230HRS upon REDACTED return home from dinner. On 01/27/2024 at 2231HRS the affiant returned to Hawkins' property. The dog was no longer outside. The affiant then went to REDACTED residence and spoke to REDACTED stated REDACTED put the dog inside Hawkins' garage. It is unknown what the living conditions are inside the garage. REDACTED stated to the affiant that the dog was barking all night on 01/26/2024 as well.

6. That, in NCPD Case #23-12464 on 11/06/2023 Hawkins was informed in person by NCPD Animal Control Officer Sean Godejohn that leaving a dog alone for a number of days without adequate food, water, and shelter is a violation of C.G.S. 53-247(a): Cruelty to Animals, and was given a warning such violation.

7. That, based on the facts and circumstances listed above, the affiant believes there is probable cause for an arrest warrant to be issued to Jack Hawkins for being in violation of C.G.S. 53-247(a): Cruelty to Animals. Hawkins being the owner of the dog, again failed to provide it with proper food, drink, and protection from the weather for multiple days. The affiant respectfully request this arrest warrant be approved.
